What are your goals for 2025?

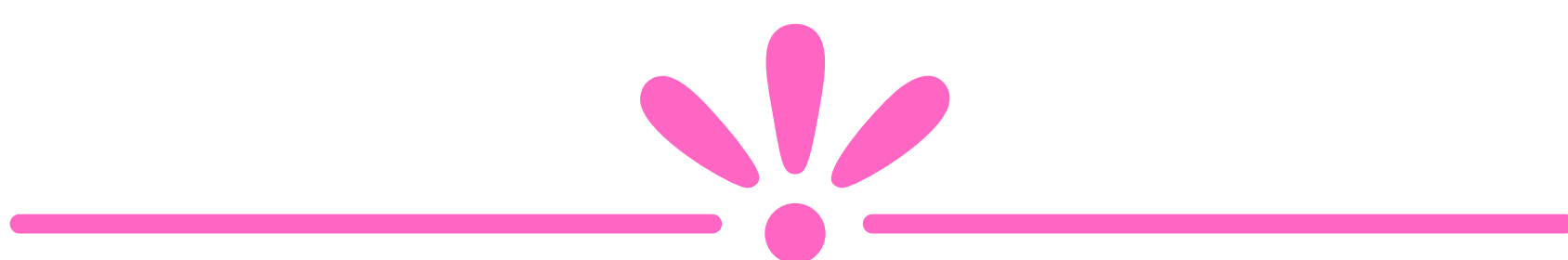
How can you complete these goals?

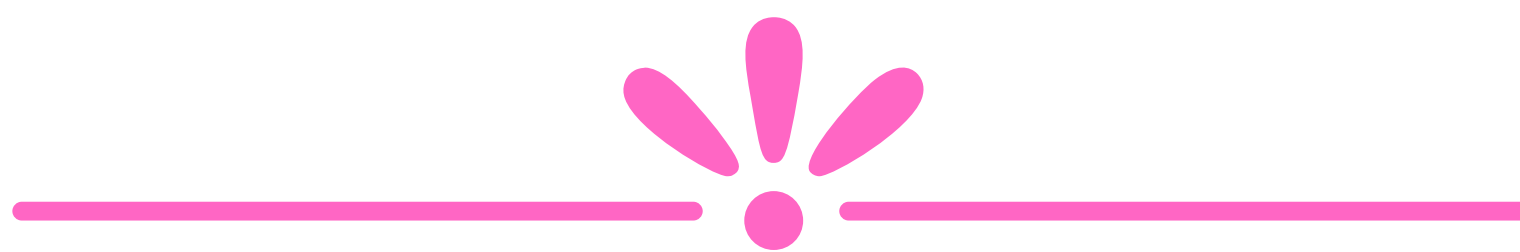


What are you good at? What are your gifts and talents? How can you use your gifts to serve others?
